
EXECUTION OF COURT DECISIONS

Ministry of Justice of Ukraine, Association of Private Enforcement Officers of Ukraine (APEO), Probation Center

The Project:

- Prepared 10 reports and publications
- Organized 20 short-term expert missions involving 30 experts



RESULTS:

- **Protection of property rights**
- Active support to the development of Private Enforcement Officers (PEOs) profession. 176 PEOs are operational, having enforced almost 3 times more judgments per case closed, to compare with the State Enforcement Service (SES), whose number of officers represents some 4,500 persons
- Developed test and practical exercise databases for PEOs qualification exam
- Supported institutional building of APEO
- Improvement of disciplinary procedure of PEOs
- Assistance to the development of APEO Strategy and its Action Plan
- ► Supported the development and implementation of New Bankruptcy Code
- Assistance to the development of concept of electronic trade system

Notary and state registration

- Support to development of test items for qualification examination for state registrars from local authorities and authorized entities
- Proposed the rules and mandate of the Working Group for the establishment of the address register
- Started working on the creation the Address Register together with other stakeholders

Execution of criminal sanctions

- Developed a draft Professional Standards for Probation Service giving basis to performance management and quality assurance
- Helped to draft the Work Plan for the development of the training system for probation officers and proposals on training programs
- Engaged civil society organizations, volunteers, and local authorities to probation activities in Ivano-Frankivsk and Dnipro regions
- Supported development of Risk and Needs Assessment Tool for Prisons
- ► Helped to conduct validation of Probation Risk and Needs Assessment Tool
- Assisted the development of Probation Human Resources Strategy and Performance Management System
- Supported development of Register of Convicts and automated tool for statistics
